Sports day

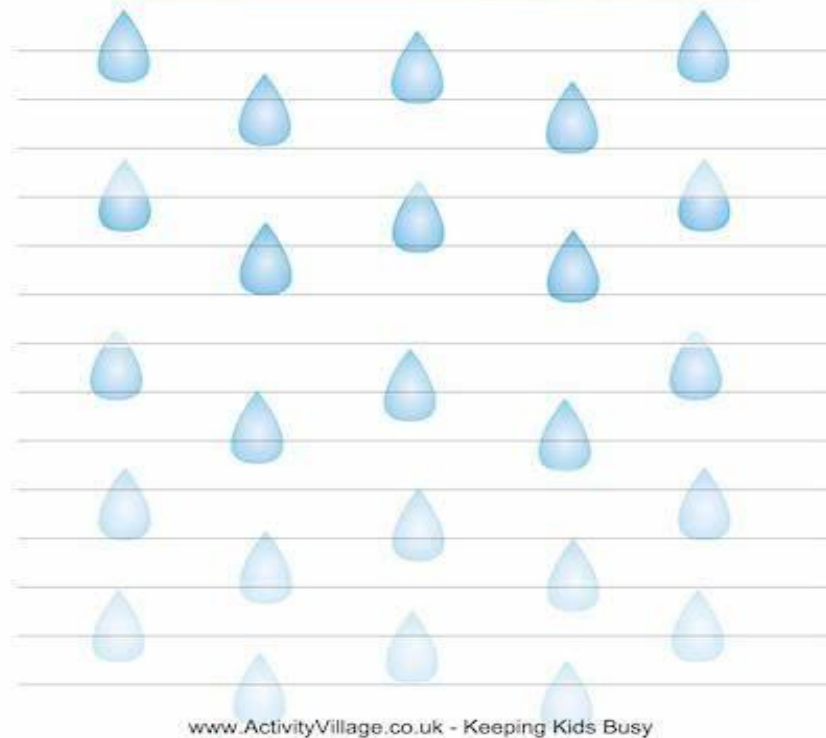
Sports day will now be held on Tuesday 25th June at 1.30pm onwards (weather permitting).
